PESA has awarded doctoral scholarships annually since 2006. The value of these scholarships is AUD 10,000. Applications for the 2019 scholarships close on the **1st of May, 2019**.

- Funding application for amounts of AUD 1000.00 or less are accepted throughout the year.
- Applications for the book award must be submitted by the 1st of May, 2019.
