

Visiting Lecturer Position Offered

Under the Global Human Resources Development initiative recently awarded to Soka University by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sport, Science & Technology (MEXT), a short-term position of *Visiting Lecturer* in the Faculty of Education at Soka University is offered.

Duration:

One semester within the time frame of September 2018 – January 2019 (Fall Semester)

Duties:

1. Lead a 15-week (one 90 minute class/week) course relating to any facet of the Education or Psychology discipline in the English language. The duration of the course may be customized to accommodate work schedules, *e.g.* two 90 minute classes/week.
2. Conduct a research lecture/seminar on a topic related to their area of expertise.
3. Publish a short research article in the Annual Bulletin of the Faculty of Education.

Qualifications:

Applicants should currently hold a teaching position at a university or college. However, experience or background in teaching, education research, leading educational seminars/lectures or education management and administration will also be considered.

Terms:

- The position and terms of appointment fall within the rules and regulations of the “Soka University Visiting Faculty Regulations”
- A stipend of JPY 250,000 will be provided every month; in the case of less than a month, the stipend will be pro-rated to JPY 8000 per-day
- Complimentary round-trip air travel (economy class) will be provided



- Complimentary faculty dormitory housing will be provided for the duration of the agreed term
- Personal research funds will not be provided and you might share an office with two or more faculty during the duration of the term
- Applicant must apply for a “working visa” for the duration of the term

Application Procedure: Please submit the following electronically,

1. Cover letter briefly outlining the type of course you would like to teach, and explicitly stating why you choose to come to Soka University.
2. Proposed syllabus, including the ≤ 15 -week content (class sizes may vary from 15 – 20 students)
3. Provisional title and summary of a public lecture (100-150w)
4. Updated *curriculum vitae* including 3 potential references. Submit electronically to: kide@soka.ac.jp addressed to the Global HR Search Committee, Faculty of Education, Soka University.

Selection Process:

Submission deadline is NOVEMBER 30, 2017. All applications will undergo careful consideration by the search committee, and will be notified of results by DECEMBER 2018.

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
